



## Eyeris Lenses Not Formulated with PFAS

Recently, there have been reports in the popular press of an independent study of many common brands of contact lenses showing inappropriate levels of PFAS or forever chemicals. The study, commissioned by Mamavation and Environmental Health News<sup>(1)</sup> tested 18 types of lenses from Johnson & Johnson, Alcon, and Coopervision. All lenses tested were found to contain 105 to 20,700 parts per million of organic fluorine. Although Eyeris lenses were not included in their study, we decided to deeply investigate any connection with our materials and PFAS.

Eyeris lenses are not manufactured with organic fluorine or any polyfluoroalkyl (PFAS) compounds. This was confirmed with our manufacturing facility, lens designer, and independent testing facility results. We took the investigation one step further and included testing of the blister pack and foil cover. PFAS were undetected in all of those components of the Eyeris product, at a threshold of less than 0.25 parts per million.

Dr. Jeffrey Sonsino, Chief Medical Officer of Eyeris, stated, “We created Eyeris to serve in the best interest of patients and independent doctors of optometry. This includes holding ourselves to the highest standards in safety and accountability and protecting patients in everything we do.”
